HOW PRE-K AFFECTS YOUR BUSINESS

HOW YOUR BUSINESS CAN HELP



The State of Mississippi provides half of the costs for providing Pre-K services, and the remaining funding is provided by local matching funds. That's why we need your help.

Your business can support a strong start for fouryear-olds in Jackson by making a monetary or in-kind donation to the program. Your business will be eligible for a 1:1 state tax credit for your gift.

Tax credits reduce your business's overall tax liability, so every dollar you contribute reduces your tax liability by one dollar. For example, if your tax liability is \$4,000 and you contribute \$500, your new liability will be \$3,500. The tax credit is first-come, first-served based on the date of the qualifying donation.

With a tax credit, you apply the credit directly to your liability.
